From TRAIL SPRING, situate on the Northerly slope of Clover Mountain,
Lincoln County, Nevada. Name of natural water source.

duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of

- (7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 250
and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 30 days during each
of the following months May, June, July, Aught., September, October,
November and December.
- (8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows: 250 from 1875 to 1880. 500 from 1880 to 1890; 1200 head from
1890 to 1900 and the same number as last stated up to 1909.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been one fortieth of a ^{40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second} cubic feet per second.

(10) The water is diverted from its source at Spring on unsurveyed land ^{True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance} feet from the _____ corner of Section _____, T. 6 S., R. 69, E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at and adjacent to said Spring which is situate _{Describe as within a 40 acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)}

Improvements: Woden trough 18" X 18" X 16 feet in length connected with Spring by 10 feet of 2 inch iron pipe with an average flow of 8 gallons per minute.

Remarks: This claimant and his predecessors in interest have been in the open, notorious, uninterrupted, peaceable and exclusive possession of said Trail Springs using the waters thereof continuously for more than thirty five years under a claim of right so to do, against all persons whomsoever, and that any and all improvements made on said Spring in the development of the waters thereof and adjacent improvements were made by and at the expense of this claimant and his predecessors.

Description of irrigated land works :-

The water is diverted through a 2-inch iron pipe 10 feet long to a wooden trough 18 in. wide by 18 in. deep by 16 feet long.

Description of use other than irrigation :-

Stock-watering and domestic purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to, the period between May 1st. and Dec. 31st., of each year, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired and is dependent upon beneficial use.
