The water is diverted through five feet of 2 in. pipe to a wooden trough 18 in. wide by 18 in. deep by 18 feet long.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the period between May 1st. and Dec. 31st., of each year, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired, and is dependent upon beneficial use.
