PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES

From ROCK SPRINGS, situate on the Northerly slope of Clover Mountain Lincoln County, Nevada. Name of natural water source.

Through Lumber tank and Iron pipe Name of ditch, pipe line, etc.

Lamond C. Woods-----, the undersigned, being first

duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by himself----- are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(1) Name of claimant Lamond C. Woods----- Address Acoma, County of Lincoln, State of Nevada.

(2) The means of diversion employed is Iron pipe and lumber tank Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in Trough 18 X 18 inches by 16 feet long and earth reservoirs Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun by claimant and his predecessors before 1875 and completed prior to 1900 and completed

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is possessory and the land upon which said springs are situate is unsurveyed

(6) The claimant's water right (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of County, at page - of Book - of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 250 and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 30 days during each of the following months May, June, July, August, September, October, November, and December.

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows: 250 head from 1875 to 1880; 500 from 1880 to 1890; 1200 head from 1890 to 1900 and the same number as last stated up to 1909.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been one
fiftieth of a cubic cubic feet per second.
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at springs, on unsurveyed lands-----feet
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance
from the ----- corner of Section -----, T.-----, R.-----,
(65.) (69E)
E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Note—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at and adjacent to the said Rock Springs which is
Situate on the Northerly slope of Clover Mountain about two miles
as shown on a map of a public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)
Remarks: South East of Willow Springs, and about four miles south of
Wood's Saw mill, in said County of Lincoln.

Improvements: Lumber tank 18 x 18 inches by 16 feet long connected
with Spring by ten feet of 2 inch iron pipe, and the surplus water
is conserved by dams built of earth at intervals below said tank.

Remarks: This claimant and his predecessors in interest, have been
in the open, notorious, uninterrupted, peaceable and exclusive
possession of said Rock springs, using the water thereof continuously
for more than thirty five years, under a claim of right so to do,
against all persons whomsoever, and that any and all improvements
made on said Spring in the development of the waters thereof
and adjacent improvements were made by and at the expense of this
claimant and his predecessors.
