

PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES

From SHEEP SPRINGS, situate on North side of Clover Mountain, Lincoln County, Nevada.

Name of natural water source.

Through Lumber trough and iron Pipe.

Name of ditch, pipe line, etc.

Lamond C. Woods, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by himself are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(1) Name of claimant Lamond C. Woods, Address Acoma, County of Lincoln, State of Nevada.

(2) The means of diversion employed is Lumber trough and iron pipe.

Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in Lumber Trough and earth reservoir.

Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun by claimant and his predecessors and completed before 1875, and completed prior to 1900.

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is possessory and the land upon which said springs are situate is unsurveyed, and a corral for stock is erected as said spring and used by Claimant.

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of County, at page of Book of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 250 and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 30 days during each of the following months May, June, July, August, September, October, November and December.

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows: 250 head from 1875 to 1880; 500 head from 1880 to 1890; 1200 head from 1890 to 1900 and the same number as last stated up to 1909.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been one
fortieth of a ----- cubic feet per second.
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at Spring, on unsurveyed lands, ----- feet
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance

Describe as within a 40 acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

~~Remarks~~ is situate on the Northerly slope of Clover Mountain about twelve miles South of Barclay, about two miles southwesterly from Woods saw mill in the center of what is known as Sheep Springs Wash, in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Improvements:- Lumber trough, 18X18'X 18 ft long connected with said spring by 10 ft of 2 in iron pipe, the said spring having a uniform flow of twelve gallons per minute, and the surplus water is conserved by dams built of earth at intervals in said wash below said trough.

Remarks:- This claimant, and his predecessors in interest have been in the open, notorious, uninterrupted, peaceable, and exclusive possession of Said Sheep Spring using the waters thereof continuously for more than thirty five years under a claim of right so to do against all persons whomsoever, and that any and all improvements made on said spring in the development of the waters thereof and adjacent improvements were made by and at the expense of this claimant and his predecessors.
