Description of irrigated-land works:-

The water is diverted into an open cut 20 feet long, 2 feet wide and 4 feet face and is impounded therein by means of earth dams.

Description of use other than irrigation :-

Stock-watering and domestic purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the period between May 1st. and Dec. 31st., of each year, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired, and is dependent upon beneficial use.
