are full and correct to the best of his
knowledge and belief.

(18) The claimant's water right was ~~(was not)~~ recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Humboldt County, said record being at page 408 of Book "A" of Water Claims, and being a claim for 400 inches of water for the irrigation of 500 acres of land in the following legal subdivisions: subdivisions not noted

(19) The map provided by the State Engineer and attached hereto as a part of this proof is hereby accepted as correctly showing the ditch lines or irrigation works diverting or conveying the water claimed and the lands irrigated.
