(8) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as enlarged are: Width on bottom 6 feet, width on  
 top 6 feet, depth 1 1/2 feet, on a grade of 0.49 to 0.52% feet per thousand feet.

(12) The water has been used for irrigation from April 1st to October 1st  
 of each year. use water for stock purposes the entire year.

(13) The water was first used for irrigation by claimant for grantors in the year 1874  
 when 80 acres were irrigated in the NW 1/4 of Sec. 20,  
T. 38 N., R. 45 E., M.D.B. & M., and SW 1/4 Sec. 17, T. 38 N.R.  
45 E., M.D.B & M.

(19) The map provided by the State Engineer and attached hereto as a part of this proof is hereby accepted as correctly showing the ditch lines or irrigation works diverting or conveying the water claimed and the lands irrigated.

(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation:.....Domestic and stock watering purposes.....

(21) Remarks: This claim for water includes all water tributary to Evans Creek above the point of diversion, shown on the map and described herein, including what is now-1912- called Summit Creek. A ditch was constructed in 1874 to carry the waters of Summit Creek to Evans Creek and it has been diverted and used each year since. The ditch has been interfered with at times. The water in Evans' creek ceases to flow from September to November each year, depending on the season. The early flood water is used on what is known as the Home Ranch and Upper Warm Spring Field owned by the Clover Valley Land & Stock Company.

I, F.W. Noble, deponent herein, have each year since 1894 personally diverted the entire Summit Creek for Beneficial Use on lands herein listed.


