PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES

From Cow Hole Spring. Name of natural water source.

Through Earthen reservoirs, dams and ditches, Name of ditch, pipe line, etc.

M. W. Laub, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by M. W. Laub, are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(1) Name of claimant M. W. Laub, Address Acoma, County of Lincoln, State of Nevada.

(2) The means of diversion employed is Reservoir, dams and ditch. Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in Earthen Reservoirs. Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun 1900, and completed 1906.

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is Possessory.

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of County, at page of Book of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 100 and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 30 days during each of the following months April, May, June, July, August, September, Oct. and November.

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows: 300 head of cattle and horses each year since 1900.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been One  
1/100 40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second ----- cubic feet per second. *(map states S 0°33'W 9978 ft)*

(10) The water is diverted from its source at a point 11000 ft S True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance feet  
from the South 1/4 Cor. ----- corner of Section 36, T. 5, S. R. 70, E.  
E. Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, would be in T. 6 S. R. 70 E. if present  
Survey was extended.  
Note - Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 5 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.
