On account of the numerous springs and boggy condition of land we find that one and one-half acre feet per acre is ample for the 391 acres of meadow land. The 29.8 acres of grain land enclosed by meadow land require about 2 acre feet per acre. All other land of 186.5 acres requires about 3 acre feet per acre.

All water in excess of that required for the above lands and desert claim of Selby Park will be used on land in sections 18-19 township 33N Range 62E. M. D. M. marked on map as land to be plowed into spring.

On account of climate and temperature of water irrigation season starts very early in spring.
