(1) Name of claimant Geo. S. Robison & Sons
Address Osceola, County of White Pine
State of Nevada

(2) The means of diversion employed is Dams ditches & flumes
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in Two troughs
Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun October 15th 1902
and completed About November 5th 1902.

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is A Squatters right. Then recorded at Ely Nev.

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of White Pine County, at page 127 of Book C of Nov 3rd 1902.

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 200 cattle and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 120 days during each of the following months. From September to January of each year according to the snow fall.

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows: From 1902 to 1908 we watered from 200 to 300 Cattle for a period of 3 to 4 months each year. From 1909 to the present time, we have ranged at various times from 1500 to 3000 sheep according to the feed and water supply.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been 3/10
Three tenths cubic feet per second.
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at N 25° 0' E 66404 feet
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance
from the N.W. corner of Section 36, T. 13 N., R. 70 E.
E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Note—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at Choke Cherry Spring No 7
Describe as within a 40 acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

October 1907 and used continually
since that time.
