duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by the Preston Irrigation Co. and their predecessors are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

(2) The means of diversion employed Dam and Ditch Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The date of the survey of ditch, canal, or pipe line was June 1906

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun June 1906 and completed Sept. 1909

(5) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as originally constructed were: Width on bottom 3 1/2 feet, width on top 4 1/2 feet, depth 1 1/2 feet, on a grade of 5 feet per thousand feet.

(6) The conduit has (has not) been enlarged. NOTE-If enlargement or extension of ditch was made, supply information under (7) and (8)

(7) The work of enlargement of the ditch or canal was begun and completed

(8) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as enlarged are: Width on bottom feet, width on top feet, depth feet, on a grade of feet per thousand feet.

(9) The claimant is (is not) an owner in the above-described conduit. sole owner If claimant is an owner in the conduit, state interest held on this line

(10) The nature of the title to the land for which the water right is claimed is Contract, Homestead Desert land and state land

(11) Crops of Hay grain and vegetables have been grown upon the land irrigated.
