Remarks: *The change in the acreage and in the location of the land irrigated was occasioned by the decrease flow and the conformation to the acquired legal subdivisions.*

The original water right was filed and owned by Joseph Bryan, grantor to the present claimant.

19) The map provided by the State Engineer and attached hereto as a part of this proof is hereby accepted as correctly showing the ditch lines or irrigation works diverting or conveying the water claimed and the lands irrigated.

(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation:

Domestic and for the watering of live stock

(21) Remarks: All the water from a creek known as Santa Clara together with some of the water from Star Creek is used to irrigate land in Section 16. This creek is dry most of the year. The flood waters from this stream and also from the Star Creek are stored in the reservoir shown on the map and used later in the season.

More land than is shown hereon has been cultivated during seasons of excessive precipitation especially in the earlier years. The decrease in the flow in recent years has made it impossible to regularly cultivate as much land as was possible in previous years.
