Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun in the year 1904  
and completed in the year 1904

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 3000  
and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of days during each  
of the following months Entire year

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been 1/2/40 cubic feet per second.  
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at Spring No. 1, bears <sup>which N.</sup> 13° 18' E 58220 feet  
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance  
from the ----- corner of Section -----, Tps 20-21N., R. 65 & 66 E.,

E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian. Spring No. 2 bears N 59° W 870ft, thence  
NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description. N 37° E 1200 ft. from No. 1

(11) The works are located at a point immediately below the springs  
Describe as within a 40 acre subdivision of public survey or by a public corner as under (10)

Remarks: The springs lie in a canon and are used for stockwatering.  
Small dams are thrown in the stream to impound the water  
for stock purposes. Garden Spring was used for irrigation  
of a small garden, whence it receives its name.
