from the corner of Section 20-21N, R 65&66  
E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian. Spring No 2 of group lies N30° 3' E 113ft,  
Spring No 3 " " " S34° W 258 ft,  
from main spring as above tied.

(11) The works are located at Within a radius of 500 feet from the main spring  
Describe as within a 40 acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: There is a small group of springs called Dipping  
springs which are used for Stockwatering and other stock  
purposes. The springs furnish water for the reservoirs  
in which it is impounded for stock use.
