(21) Remarks: Total length of pipe line from Rabbit Springs the
source, to the distributing system of the Town of Goldfield,
County of Esmeralda, State of Nevada, the terminus, is 998
feet.

This water system was constructed by the predecessors
in interest of the applicant and prior to its acquisition by
the applicant, and said applicant has no knowledge concern-
ing the facts set out in paragraphs number 3 to number 8,
except that applicant has been informed that said conduit
contains 598 feet of 4 inch and 400 feet of 2 inch pipe.
Applicant has diligently sought the information desired in
said paragraphs but owing to the fact that said pipe line
was constructed a comparatively long time ago and that all
of the persons who were in any way connected with its
construction have departed from Goldfield, it has been unable
to secure any definite information concerning the specifica-
tions of said conduit.

There are no other claimants to the use of this water
and there never have been except the predecessors in interest
of this claimant.

The amount of water appropriated by this claimant is
.0093 second feet, which is equivalent to 6,000 gallons per
twenty-four hours. The purposes for which the water now is
and has been heretofore used are domestic purposes, and it
has never been used for irrigation.
