PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR IRRIGATION

From Meadow Valley and Clover Creeks in Meadow Valley Wash, Lincoln County, Nevada. Name of natural water source

Through well, pipe-line and tank Name of ditch, flume, or pipe line

F.A. Waters, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by San Pedro, Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

Deponent is an officer to-wit: General Right of Way and Tax Agent of Claimant Corporation.

(1) Name of claimant San Pedro, Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company. Address 507 Pacific Electric Bldg. County of Los Angeles. State of California

(2) The means of diversion employed well, pipe-line and tank. Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The date of the survey of ditch, canal, or pipe line was January, 1911.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun On or about January, 1911, and completed on or about January, 1911

(5) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as originally constructed were: Width on bottom See remarks. feet, width on top feet, depth feet, on a grade of feet per thousand feet.

(6) The conduit has (has not) been enlarged. NOTE-If enlargement or extension of ditch was made, supply information under (7) and (8)

(7) The work of enlargement of the ditch or canal was begun and completed

(8) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as enlarged are: Width on bottom feet, width on top feet, depth feet, on a grade of feet per thousand feet.

(9) The claimant is (is not) an owner in the above-described conduit.

Claimant is absolute owner of said conduit works. If claimant is an owner in the conduit, state interest held on this line

(10) The nature of the title to the land for which the water right is claimed is not claimed for land

(11) Crops of none have been grown upon the land irrigated.



(19) The map provided by the State Engineer and attached hereto as a part of this proof is hereby accepted as correctly showing the ditch lines or irrigation works diverting or conveying the water claimed and the lands irrigated.

(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: To supply water for general railroad purposes.

(21) Remarks: This water station is located on unsurveyed land at or near Mile Post 440 of said railroad; the size of the pipe from the well to the tank is 4 inches. Reference is made to map attached hereto drawn by E.G.Tilton, Chief Engineer of said railroad company, showing said works.
