From 210 to 350 head. The number varied
from year to year depending on
conditions

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been One fortieth cubic feet per second.
40 minutes inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source in Lot 6
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance
from the ~~_____~~ corner of Section 1, T. 27N, R. 34E,
S, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at Lot 6 Sec. 1-T 27N R 34E 2nd DBM
Describe as within a 40 acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: The first owner of this spring was Mr Fisher who used water for irrigating a garden. Fisher sold to John Reid. Reid sold to Mrs Larson and Larson to Peter Anker and Peter Anker to James Philip Anker.
Water is used for domestic purposes during the entire year whenever it is necessary to be at the spring.


