PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR IRRIGATION

From Bens Creek. Name of natural water source

Through Pipe Line. Name of ditch, flume, or pipe line

R. T. Jenkins, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by W. T. Jenkins Company are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(1) Name of claimant W. T. Jenkins Company. Address Battle Mountain, County of Lander, State of Nevada.

(2) The means of diversion employed Cement flume and dam. Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The date of the survey of ditch, canal, or pipe line was 1907

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun 1909 and completed November 1909

(5) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as originally constructed were: Width on bottom 4 feet, width on top 6 feet, depth 2 feet, on a grade of 30 feet per thousand feet.

(6) The conduit has (has not) been enlarged. NOTE - If enlargement or extension of ditch was made, supply information under (7) and (8)

(7) The work of enlargement of the ditch or canal was begun and completed

(8) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as enlarged are: Width on bottom feet, width on top feet, depth feet, on a grade of feet per thousand feet.

(9) The claimant is (is not) an owner in the above-described conduit. Owner of pipe line. If claimant is an owner in the conduit, state interest held on this line

(10) The nature of the title to the land for which the water right is claimed is patent

(11) Crops of alfalfa, grain, vegetables, grass hay have been grown upon the land irrigated.

(12) The water has been used for irrigation from April 1st to July 20th of each year.

(13) The water was first used for irrigation by claimant or its grantors in the year 1885 when 160 acres were irrigated in the Prof. S 1/2 of Sec. 34 T. 31 N., R. 45 E. and about 80 acres in grain in Sec. 4, 5 T. 30 N., R. 45 E.

* This date was changed to 1885 in the certificate for the reason that a former certificate on the source with date of first use of 1884 was given, priority No. 1 after an investigation and hearing held several years ago. Engner in S. Case.

(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation:

(21) Remarks: The amount of water flowing thru a one-inch pipe has been used for garden culture, being diverted from Ben's Creek just above the intake of the W. T. Jenkins' Co. pipe line. This is the only other water right along the said Ben's Creek.
