(5) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as originally constructed were: Width on bottom pipe line all 2" feet; width on top feet; depth feet; on a grade of feet per thousand feet.

(6) The amount of water claimed is about 55 3/4 second-feet.

(7) The conduit has (has not) been enlarged. (NOTE: If enlargement or extension of ditch was made, supply information under (7) and (8.)

(8) The work of enlargement of the ditch or canal was begun and completed

(9) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as enlarged are: Width on bottom feet; width on top feet; depth feet; on a grade of feet per thousand feet.

(10) The claimant is an owner in the above-described conduit. took a deed from administrator of estate of Joseph Trevelli, deceased. - the former user. (If claimant is an owner in the conduit, state interest held on this line.)

(20) Remarks: In regard to question 3; Joseph Trevelli and his grantors had used this well, and part of the pipe line for at least fifteen years. Trevelli died in 1912, and his administrator deeded the land to the Mineral Hill Consolidated Mines Company, said deed reciting "Together with all water and water rights". When Mr. Trevelli died no map or notes of survey could be located.
