NOTICE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER.

Notice is hereby given that, in accordance with the provisions of the laws of the State of Nevada respecting Water Rights, the undersigned, has appropriated, and hereby appropriate one thousand inches of water, measured under a four inch pressure, flowing in Rock Creek, in T. 34 N., R. 23 E., M.D.B.&M. in the County of Washoe, State of Nevada. That the purpose for which the undersigned claims said water is for irrigating agricultural lands. That they intend to divert it from said creek at a point on the right bank of said creek (at which point a duplicate of this notice is posted), and to conduct said water thence down the right bank of said stream in an easterly direction about 1 mile to Granite Creek, thence down Granite Creek to the land to be irrigated and for all purposes incident thereto. That the means by which the undersigned intend to divert said water is by a ditch and said Granite Creek _____ feet wide at the top, _____ feet wide at the bottom, and _____ feet deep, _____ and
