PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES

From Indian Spring Name of natural water source.

Through troughs Name of ditch, pipe line, etc.

W.H. McGill, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by Adams-McGill Company are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

(1) Name of claimant Adams-McGill Company Address Ely, County of White Pine, State of Nevada

(2) The means of diversion employed is troughs and dam Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in troughs and dam Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun prior to 1905 and completed prior to 1905

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is Possession and Purchase from John Meloy the original appropriator and continues beneficial use since appropriation

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of County, at page of Book of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 25 cattle and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of every year days during each of the following months since the original appropriation

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows: 25 to 250 cattle and several thousand sheep each and every year since the original appropriation

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been 1/2 Miner inch cubic feet per second.
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at N 42° 44' E 23850 feet
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance
 from the NE corner of Section , T. 3 N, R. 64 E,
 E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Note—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at Spring
Describe as within a 40 acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10).
