the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by Adams-Mc Gill Co. are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

(1) Name of claimant Adams-Mc Gill Co Address Ely, County of White Pine State of Nevada.

(2) The means of diversion employed is troughs Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in troughs Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun prior to 1905 and completed prior to 1905-

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is possession obtained by purchase from John Meloy and continued use since said purchase.

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 25 cattle and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of every year days during each of the following months since the original development

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows: From 25 to 250 cattle, and several thousand sheep, for each and every year, since development

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been $\frac{1}{2}$ ~~miner~~ ^{miner} in ~~cubic feet per second~~.

(10) The water is diverted from its source at $N. 16^{\circ} - 29' E. 5 - 10 \frac{46}{4}$ feet
from the ~~NE~~ ^{NE} corner of Section ~~T. 3 N., R. 6 4 E.~~,
E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

(11) The works are located at spring
Describe as within a 40 acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)
