(10) The water is diverted from its source at S 34 1/2 W 19290 feet }  
S 34 40 W 19710 feet }  
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance

from the N.E. Co corner of Section T. 6 N., R. 65 E  
E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

These springs flow about two miners inches water  
but would be unfit for the watering of stock without  
the development of some improved
