(3) The water is impounded in trough 200 x 1 x 1 feet  
Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun prior to 1905  
and completed prior to 1905

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is Proprietary  
obtained by purchase and by continued use,

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows: 50 to 150 Cattle, and several thousand sheep  
also water at the spring each and every year,

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been four  
million inches cubic feet per second.  
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at S 31° <sup>03'</sup> W. 18870 feet  
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance  
from the N. E. corner of Section T. 6 N., R. 65 E.  
E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Note—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at the Spring  
Describe as within a 40 acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: The springs were purchased from James  
Lewis in 1900 who used and appropriated the  
water for many years. Since the purchase the  
water has been used the entire year for water  
stock.

The spring is located in Lincoln County Nevada  
and has about 4 million inches of water  
is upon unsurveyed land
