PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES

From North Mud Spring Name of natural water source.

Through Trough Name of ditch, pipe line, etc.

W.F. McGill, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by Adams - McGill Co. are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

(2) The means of diversion employed is water trough
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in water trough
Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun prior to 1904
and completed prior 1905

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is Possession
obtained by Purchase from John Nelson and continued
use of same ever year since

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of
County, at page of Book of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 25 Cattle
and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of every year days during each
of the following months since the original development

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:
25 to 300 head each and ever year also
several thousand sheep water at these springs.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been three
millers inches 56,039 cubic feet per second.

(10) The water is diverted from its source at N 17° 29' E 56039 feet feet
from the NE corner of Section T. 3N, R. 64E,
E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at the Spring.
Describe as within a 40 acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: This spring is located upon unsurveyed land in Lincoln Co., Nev., and little was had by Purchaser from ~~land~~ John McRoy who used the springs for many years prior to sale. These springs have been used for watering cattle and sheep each and every year since.
