Edward Reinhart, Secretary of the Winnemucca Water and Light Co the undersigned, being first  
duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by The  
Winnemucca Water and Light Co are full and correct to the best of his  
knowledge and belief.

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Remarks: 116 Acres of pasture as shown on map on file in State Engro office is in pasture, rye grass and light usage with other grasses was once in cultivation and is located in S 1/2 of N.E. 1/4 and W 1/2 of S.E. 1/4 Sec. 26 T. 35 N. R. 37 E., M.D.B and Med.,. The lands as shown is all that could be irrigated here of late years on account of shortage of water, but formerly the entire 240 acres was in cultivation, the last time the entire acres was cultivated was in 1910, better shown by affidavit attached to this document, signed by Wm Nelson the original locator.

- (15) The maximum acreage irrigated in any year was ~~Not known~~ 240 acres.
- (16) The water claimed has (has not) been used for irrigation each and every year since the right was initiated. <sup>Strike out one not wanted</sup> Yes when there was enough at hand to irrigate the entire tract.
- (17) The years during which no water was used for irrigation or during which the full water right was not used were Not known exactly, but was from 1886 to 1910.



(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: Stock-watering and domestic use

(21) Remarks: As previously mentioned all of the land was once in cultivation and has been worked more or less from 1886 to 1914, ie, when there was enough water to take care of the entire acreage, but here of late years, there has not been enough water to irrigate what lands we have in meadow and pasture, but it is our purpose to again try to work the entire 240 acres, using less water per acre and in a more economic manner, also to repair the ditches above the lands named so as to prevent the water from sinking ~~out~~ before it reaches the lands to be irrigated.

The Original locator Wm Nelson hereby attaches his affidavit stating when he first irrigated the land, and how much at one time was irrigated, the dates etc.
