

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

2500 head of sheep,

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been estimated 4000 gallons every 24 hours,
cubic feet per second.

40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at about 1980 feet from
the North West corner of Section 28, T. 18 N., R. 56 E., E.,
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at about center of the 40 acre tract described below.
