(21) Remarks: The attached map is herewith made a part of the proof. This spring rises upon the land described herein and water does not flow off the same. This water has been used for bathing and medicinal as well as for irrigation for a long period of years; and I purpose to so continue the use of said water for all of said purposes and maintain the bathhouses now erected or to be hereafter erected by me for said bathing and medicinal purposes. And I further purpose to increase the to increase the water from said springs and the vicinity of said springs by sinking wells and pumping the water from said wells onto the lands herewith described and also the land in the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 19.
