

ADDENDUM TO
AMENDED PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR IRRIGATION
UPON NOBLE CREEK
BY ESTATE OF AGNES ROSE GOODWIN

Item 13:

The total flow of water of Noble Creek is claimed as a vested right by reason of the Proof submitted by Ernest C. Wood, the Ditch Right executed by John C. Wood and pursuant to Contract of Sale executed by Russell Wilkins, et al to Ray Goodwin, et ux, recorded in Book 13 of Miscellaneous Records at Page 531, Elko County, Nevada, a copy attached hereto.

In addition, the tributary to Noble Creek (Unnamed Creek) is included in this Amended Proof. It is apparent that this was omitted in the original Proof 1389A, but should have been included for the reason that Noble Creek Ditch No. 1 diverts water to this tributary and co-mingles the waters of Noble Creek and the Unnamed Creek.

The years of priority and acreage claimed are based upon the previously submitted proof and the "Doctrine of Relation Back" as recognized in Nevada for a priority of 1868.

Items 13 and 17:

Ernest C. Wood claims irrigation of certain lands and years of priority.

Proof dated July 14, 1915, Serial Filing No. 1389A (a copy attached hereto). This Proof and Water Right recorded in Book 1 of Water Rights at Page 163 is the basis for the statement herein. Property claimed as irrigated therein is erroneously described as evidenced by recorded documents of record which describe lands owned prior to 1905. The description should read as follows:

The waters of Noble Creek are co-mingled in land subdivisions owned by the claimant, and therefore it is not possible to clearly state the acreage irrigated from each source. The Proofs submitted under Proof 1389 and 1389A claim a total of 990 acres of irrigated acres. It is apparent that from comparing the culture map submitted under 1389 and 1389A which showed 741.05 and the culture map prepared with this amended proof which shows 769.09 acres, that the previous Proofs were on the basis of co-mingling of the waters.





The priority claimed for all acreage is 1868 under the Doctrine of Relation Back.

It is apparent that errors were made in the proof submitted, and this proof is hereby amended to read as above with a total of 769.90 acres being claimed as a vested right between Proof 1389 and 1389A, either by irrigation prior to 1905 or through the Doctrine of Relation Back. Portions of said acreage are watered from Noble and Chase Creek or waters co-mingled which flow from Steele Creek and Noble Creek.

NOTE: E1/2, Sec. 23, T35N, R61E acquired by Frank Johnson Land & Cattle Company in 1917. Some time between 1917 and 1926, Woods acquired NE1/4 and a vested water right is claimed thereon.

The original Proof 1389 does not state use of water from the unnamed creek (Woods Creek on Culture Map for Proof 1389) or Chase Creek. However, this amendment claims such use for the reason that Woods Ditch collected those waters at the time of construction and they have been in use upon the lands described herein since.
