(2) The means of diversion employed is Reservoir dam

(3) The water is impounded in Reservoir dam in main channel  
Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun Prior to 1898  
and completed as it now is 1910

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is Possessory right acquired by purchase from predecessors in interest

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

in 1907 I purchased this Spring and have been watering an average of 3000 head of Sheep and 5 head of Horses during the months of March, April, May, Sept., Oct and Nov of each year

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

$\frac{1}{40}$  cubic feet per second.

40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second
