(21) The character of the soil is gravelly (Sandy, gravelly, loam). The soil needs 5 acre-feet per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of 1.67 cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of 6 months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

Remarks: The map furnished by me and forwarded to your office is hereby made a part of this proof. This map shows the land that can be irrigated.
