Mrs. Lena Leick, the undersigned, being first
duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by
herself are full and correct to the best of his
knowledge and belief.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun about 1890
and completed same year

(5) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as originally constructed were: Width on bottom 2
feet, width on top 4 feet, depth 1 1/2 feet, on a grade of 17 feet per thousand feet.

(6) The conduit has (has not) been enlarged.

(7) The work of enlargement of the ditch or canal was begun
and completed

(8) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as enlarged are: Width on bottom feet, width on
top feet, depth feet, on a grade of feet per thousand feet.

(9) The claimant is (is not) an owner in the above-described conduit.

(10) The nature of the title to the land for which the water right is claimed is Possessory claim
but will be entered under Homestead and Desert laws when open
for entry.

(11) Crops of alfalfa and grain
have been grown upon the land irrigated.

(12) The water has been used for irrigation from March to September
of each year.

(15) The maximum acreage irrigated in any year was 20 acres.

(16) The water claimed has ~~has not~~ been used for irrigation each and every year since the right was initiated.

(17) The years during which no water was used for irrigation or during which the full water right was not used were. If water was not used, or used in reduced quantity at any time, full information as to causes and duration of non-use should be given, appending a sheet if necessary

(18) The claimant's water right ~~was~~ (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of County, said record being at page of Book of and being a claim for acres of water for the irrigation of acres of land in the following legal subdivisions:

(19) The map provided by the State Engineer and attached hereto as a part of this proof is hereby accepted as correctly showing the ditch lines or irrigation works diverting or conveying the water claimed and the lands irrigated.

(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: Stock purposes

(21) The character of the soil is gravelly (Sandy, gravelly, loam). The soil needs 5 acre-feet per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of 1.67 cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of 6 months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

Remarks: The map furnished by me and forwarded to your office is hereby made a part of this proof. This map shows the land I intend to irrigate.


