PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES

From Soda Spring, White Pine County, Nevada. Name of natural water source.

Through 1" Pipe Line Name of ditch, pipe line, etc.

Thomas Dixon, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by himself are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(1) Name of claimant Thomas Dixon Address Eureka, County of Eureka State of Nevada

(2) The means of diversion employed is 1" pipe line 194 feet from spring to troughs Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in troughs Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun about the year 1885 and completed same year

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is possessory (government land)

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of County, at page of Book of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 50 and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 30 days during each of the following months April, May, June, July, August, September and November,

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows: From 50 to 100 head during each and every year since said date of 1885.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purposes has been.....

.015 (One-tenth) cubic feet per second.
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at $89^{\circ} 5'$ south east, 20,692 feet
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance
from the North West corner of Section 30, T. 16 N., R. 56 E.

E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Note--Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at 194 feet south west of point described in (10)
Describe as within a 40 acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: Water is conveyed from this spring through a one inch pipe line to a distance of 194 feet where two and sometimes three 25 gal. barrels are used as troughs. Said works were constructed by myself and other parties who abandoned the same during the early 80s, and I have continued to use and divert said waters continuously since said time for stockwatering and domestic purposes.
