duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by Nora

Hayden are full and correct to the best of his her  
knowledge and belief.

(1) Name of claimant Mrs Nora Hayden, widow of N.P. Hayden, deceased  
Address Battle Mountain, County of Lander  
State of Nevada

(2) The means of diversion employed open ditch  
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The date of the survey of ditch, canal, or pipe line was private survey made in 1899

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun in 1899  
and completed in 1902

(5) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as originally constructed were: Width on bottom 18 inches  
~~ft~~ width on top 3 feet, depth one foot, on a grade of 5 to 10 feet per thousand feet.

(6) The conduit ~~has~~ (has not) been enlarged.

(7) The work of enlargement of the ditch or canal was begun none

(8) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as enlarged are: Width on bottom none feet, width on

have been grown upon the land irrigated, each year.

(12) The water has been used for irrigation from April 15th to September 30th

(13) The water was first used for irrigation by claimant or grantors in the year 1900  
when five acres were irrigated in the Lot one of Section 19 said Twp

occupying the N.W. 1/4 of N.W. 1/4 of said Section  
19 and the N.E. 1/4 of N.E. 1/4 of said Section  
24, Twp 31 North Range 40 East  
also North east 1/4 of  
N.E. 1/4 of Section 24, Twp 31 North Range 40 East  
These two subdivisions being a total of 80 acres  
more or less
