Thomas Dixon, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by him are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been used entire flow of spring during dry months.

(10) The water is diverted from its source at S. 74° 09' E., 5096.0 feet from the northwest corner of Section 6, T. 18 N., R. 55 E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.
