(2) The means of diversion employed is 2 1/2" Galvanic pump
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in 1700 gal. galvanized iron storage tank, as cement tank 2' x 4' x 15'
Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun (see records) and completed.....

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is None

(6) The claimant's water right ~~was~~ (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of County, at Page..... of Book..... of.....

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 240 and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 30 days during each ^{year} of the following months March 15 to Apr. 15

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

15,000 gal per day cubic-foot-per-second.
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at S. 35° 24' W. 26.333 feet from the N.E. corner of Section 1, T. 10 N., R. 33 E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at a point S. 35° 24' W. 26.333 ft from Sec. 1, T. 10 N., R. 33 E. Describe as within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: Well was sunk by Knight and Bowler in 1889 and abandoned in the spring of 1890. Later used by Antone Lewis until death in 1911. In 1910 claimant, with Lewis' consent watered 200 more or less cattle. After Mr Lewis' death claimant purchased improvements from the estate. In Nov 1914 the ~~spring~~ ^{consent} tank was built, and storage tank installed the following spring. Nov 1915 gasoline pump was installed also a foot valve. Prior to the installation of pump water was raised by buckets and hand power.

I am unable to definitely state year Lewis first used the water, but know Lewis was using the well in the Fall of 1904.
