is used for irrigation. The water is carried from the
tank to the fields by a pipe. The water is used for
irrigation from 11. 1908. The water is carried to the
fields by a pipe.

Remarks: 300 ft. Tunnel, a cut 320 ft. long, a cement tank 6 x 6 x 40 ft.
230 ft. of 3 1/2" pipe, conveying water to six troughs 1' x 3' - 14'
