thus far affiant has been unable to find any record of the above described ditch, in the Office of the County Recorder, State of Nevada.

NOTE—Failure to record in the county in no way invalidates a water right, but if ditch or right was so recorded, supply full information under (10)

(19) The map provided by the State Engineer and attached hereto as a part of this proof is hereby accepted as correctly showing the ditch lines or irrigation works diverting or conveying the water claimed and the lands irrigated.

(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: watering stock

(21) The character of the soil is loam (Sandy, gravelly, loam). The soil needs one acre-foot per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of one-half cubic ~~foot~~ foot of water per second, during the irrigation season of six months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

Remarks: There is rarely ever a flow from the above mentioned stream to exceed one-half second foot, except in the early spring, there is rarely any water for irrigation purposes after July 15th, each year.
