David B. Gemmill, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by Geyser Land & Cattle Co. are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

This proof is made in persuance of instructions from the officers of the Geyser Land & Cattle Co.  
If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant

(1) Name of claimant Geyser Land & Cattle Co.  
Address Geyser, County of Lincoln, State of Nevada.

(2) The means of diversion employed is Dam and Pipe line  
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in Troughs  
Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun Probably between 1880 1890 and completed same time

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is Held by virtue of transfers from prior claimants all of whom used the water. Land unpattented.

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of \_\_\_\_\_ County, at Page \_\_\_\_\_ of Book \_\_\_\_\_ of Geyser ranch

(7) Recorded in connection with the various transfers of the entire The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was not known and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 30 days during each of the following months all months.

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

The number of cattle varied according to the number of cattle on the range owned by the Geyser Ranch. From several thousand down as low as 300 during the past five years the owners of the Geyser ranch has owned 700 cattle and at one time 4000 sheep

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been One-tenth (0.10) cubic feet per second.

40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at point 27017 ft. S. 45 20' W. feet from the South West corner of Section 35, T. 9N., R. 65 E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance

Note—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at same point as discribed in IO

Describe as within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: Milk Ranch was first claimed by a party who kept a few Milch cows at the time of the mining excitment in Patterson Gap Since that time it has been held the property of the various owners og the Geyser Ranch. and has been constantly used and repaired by them.
