(1) Name of claimant Geyser Land & Cattle Co.

(2) The means of diversion employed is Dam and pipe line.

Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in Troughs

Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun Probably between 1870 & 1880 and completed September 1914 ( Installed present pipe and trough)

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is Held by virtue of transfers from prior claimants all of whom used the water. Land is unpatented land no actual title

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of County, at Page of Book of Recorded in connection with the various transfers of the Geyser Ranch

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was not known and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 30 days during each of the following months every month

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

The number has varied according to the number of cattle on the range owned by the Geyser ranch. Green Campbell ran several thousand cattle along in the ninties. During the past five years the claimant and its predecessors have owned 700 cattle and as many as 4000 sheep which have watered at the spring whenever they wished.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

One tenth (0.10) cubic feet per second.

40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at a point 12589 ft. S. 83 20' W. feet from

True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance

the South West corner of Section 35, T. 9 N., R. 65 E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

(11) The works are located at Point described in answer to question 10

Remarks: Roadside Spring is mentioned in all the transfers of the Geyser Ranch property and also appears on all the tax lists. How much has been done in times past towards diverting the water is not known. This September, however, the present claimant made the improvements indicated on the accompanying map. The water has been used for the past 30 years by the Geyser Ranch in watering cattle.
