(2) The means of diversion employed is pipe line  
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in trough 18ft. long by 2 ft. wide and 2 ft. deep.  
Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun more than 20 years ago  
and completed more than twenty years ago.

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is  
fee simple title

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 20,  
and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 30 days during each  
of the following months May, June, July, August, September, October, November  
and December. The number increased in the fall of each year any  
where from eighty to one hundred head of cattle watered there in  
August, September, October, November and December, as they gradually  
worked down from the mountains.

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows: The number increased each year from 30 to 40 watering at this trough from 1900 on, during the months of May, June, July and August of each year, and as the cattle worked down from the mountains 100 to 125 would water there during the months of September, October, November and December until put in the fields for winter feeding. This number has been maintained since about the year 1900.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been All of the water. cubic feet per second.

40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at between 200 and 300 feet from the NW cor. of NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  ~~corner~~ of Section 20, T. 25 N., R. 49 E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 5 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at near NW cor. of NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said section 20.

Describe as within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: Troughs were placed at this spring, known as and called Willow Spring, which is known as the most Westerly spr of the three springs on the 40 acre tract, said troughs being rebuilt at different times, as necessary. The first trough being placed there over twenty years ago, and since the first trough was placed all the water of this spring has been conducted and diverted through the pipe to the trough for the purpose of watering stock; not only have cattle watered there in the numbers given but horses have also watered there, and do water there at the present time.
