(21) The character of the soil is gumbo (Sandy, gravelly, loam). The soil needs _____ acre-feet per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of _____ cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of _____ months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

Remarks: All the water of all the streams is required for the irrigation of the land shown in the plat.
