(10) The water is diverted from its source at N. 45° E 5280 feet from the Baldy PK ^{from SW cor. of sec. 30} ~~corner of Section~~ True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance, T. 5 S., R. 56 E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.
