(2) The means of diversion employed is by means of earthen dams so as to form  
reservoirs  
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in reservoirs  
Troughs, reservoirs, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun in about 1875  
and completed same year and each year when necessary. Floods sometimes  
destroy works and they must be renewed.

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is

(6) The claimant's water right ~~was~~ (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 150,  
and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 30-31 days during each  
of the following months throughout the entire year.

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

25 to 200 head cattle

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been One tenth (1/10) cubic feet per second.  
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at a point S. 70° E, 1300 feet from the 7-H.E.S. corner of Section the G.B. Welsh Homestead in E., T. 2 N. R. 56 E. M.D.B. of Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian.  
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance

NOTE—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at a point S. 70° E 1300 feet from the 7-H.E.S. corner of the G.B. Welsh homestead as within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in same manner as under (10)

Remarks: The waters of the above source have been used since the year about 1875. There is a spring or springs rising in the bed of Pine Creek at the above named point. It flows after the flood water passes. The pools and ponds are constructed of earth.
