Remarks:

Between the extreme points above mentioned there are numerous small dams in the Creek bed which are and have been constructed from Year to Year for watering stock. These dams wash out during the floods but must be reconstructed so as to retain the water during the period of low flow

Claimant claims the right to water stock at such points, that is to say, at the 3 specific points mentioned and at any point between Corner #5 of Homestead Survey and #198 and the S E Corner sec. 18 T 2 N R. 59 E along the Channel of Cherry Creek

Remarks:

Water has been diverted to the desert flat for stock use through plow furrow ditches, particularly at a point about 4 miles East of Corner #5 above referred to at the site of the Cattle Corral on said Cherry Creek in Garden Valley.
