(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is Vested right ^{to water} through beneficial use prior to 1905, but no claim or right to land which is neither agricultural nor mineral.

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimants during the first year was 150, and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 30 days during each of the following months of the subsequent years down to date, whenever there was any water to be had there, i.e., when it had not dried up.

(8)^a The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:
Not less than 150 head, and sometimes as high as
300 head, have been watered there by claimants
continuously since 1902, the number being dependent
on the volume of water, which is variable.

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

(10) The water is diverted from its source at S. 43° 20' E., 203 feet from
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance
the N. W. corner of Section 27, T. 3 S., R. 69 E.,
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.
