Peter Carletti, the undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by himself and his predecessors in interest are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun in the year 1872 and completed in the same year

(5) The dimensions of the ditch or canal as originally constructed were/ Approximately Width on bottom 5 ft. feet, width on top 12 feet, depth 10 feet, on a grade of 10 feet per thousand feet.

(6) The conduits (has not) been enlarged.

(7) The work of enlargement of the ditch or canal was begun ~~xxxx~~ not enlarged except by natural erosion and completed

(13) The water was first used for irrigation by claimant or his grantors in the year 1872 when 229.9 acres were irrigated in the NE 1/4 of Sec. 34 and SW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 35, Tp. 25 N, R. 51 E; and the E 1/2 of SE 1/2 of Sec. 2, SW 1/2 of SW 1/2 of Sec. 1, E 1/2 of NE 1/4 of Section 11, W 1/2 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 12, SE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 12, SW 1/4 of Sec. 12, and E 1/2 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 13, Tp. 24 N, R. 51 E. M. D. B. & M.

The map provided by the ~~State~~ Engineer and attached hereto as a part of this proof is hereby accepted as correctly showing the ditch lines or irrigation works diverting or conveying the water claimed and the lands irrigated.

(20) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: Domestic and stock-watering purposes.

(21) The character of the soil is sandy and loam. The soil needs 1 acre-foot per annum to properly irrigate the crops. A continuous flow of One cubic feet of water per second, during the irrigation season of 5 months, is needed to irrigate each 100 acres of land.

(22) Remarks: Garden Valley Creek flows upon and through the lands owned by affiant, and all the waters therefrom have been continuously used by affiant and his predecessors, upon the above described lands, and there is no waste waters, or waters not needed or used by affiant.
