PROOF OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STOCK WATERING PURPOSES

From Wild Cat Spring

duly sworn, deposes and says that the statements herein contained relative to the appropriation of water by Adams-McGill Co are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

(2) The means of diversion employed is pipe
Dam and ditch, pipe line, flume, etc.

(3) The water is impounded in galvanized water trough
Trough, reservoir, tanks, etc.

(4) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun eighteen hundred and ninety eight and completed in 1917

(5) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the works are located is filed in U.S. Land office

(6) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of _____ County, at Page _____ of Book _____ of _____

(7) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year was 500 Cattle and said watering was conducted for an approximate period of 365 days during each year of the following months since the original appropriation which was prior to the year 1898

(8) The approximate number of animals watered by claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

ten thousand sheep have watered at wild cat Spring each year since the year 1895, and since that time both cattle and sheep have been watering at these springs

(9) The amount of water which it has been necessary to divert for the said purpose has been

$\frac{1}{2}$ second foot ~~cubic feet per second~~ - all of the water of the spring
40 miners inches equals 1 cubic foot per second

(10) The water is diverted from its source at 756.5 ft N 6° 15' E feet from
True bearing to nearest 5 minutes distance
the S.W. corner of Section 15, T. 10 N., R. 64 E.,
Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Note—Information under (10) must invariably be given when a public corner is within 6 miles, unless the State Engineer consents to some other form of description.

(11) The works are located at the spring
Describe as within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey or by a tie in some manner as under (10)

Remarks: In eighteen hundred and ninety eight the water of wild cat was impounded in small pools and reservoirs so that live stock could conveniently drink during 1904 wooden troughs 12x12x100 feet long were placed for watering stock; during the year 1917 the wooden troughs were replaced with stone troughs.
