(22) Remarks: for many years prior to 1910 approximately 20 acres
of land was cultivated as described and in Jan 1910 the heavy floods
washed away all the ditches and took away most of the cultivated
land and made it necessary to construct new ditches and clear and
break new land a part of which has been done within the last four
years as shown by the ~~xxxxx~~ attached map.

The claimant has under cultivation at present 3 acres of garden.....
and has part of the brush cleared from the 10 acres which is intended
to be placed under cultivation this season.
