holdings of the Cordova Estate, consisting of livestock, land and
improvements. In the deed from the said Cordova Estate to us, we
were deeded eighty acres of land near Como, Lyon Co, Nevada, which
we understood was the $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$ and the $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 7 T. 15 N. -
R. 23 E. M. D. B. & M. But upon investigation we found that the above
described land was Public Domain. To the best of our knowledge and
belief the late Mr Cordova thought his title to this land was vested
in him as for many years he paid taxes on the same. Indian or Pony
Spring is situated in the $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 7 and the water from
said spring was piped to troughes, which were either built by the
late Mr. Cordova or his predecessor in business, and use for stock
watering purposes for at least twenty years prior to the time of
the transfer to us.
